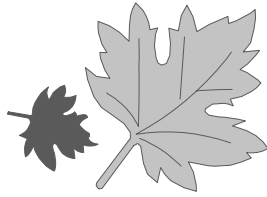
Web Site

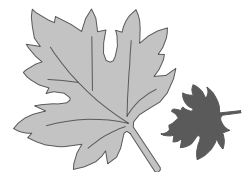
